NORFOLK – Downtown Norfolk Restaurant Week begins Sunday with dozens of restaurants offering discounted menus with set prices, according to the Downtown Norfolk Council.

Multi-course dinners will be priced at \$25 or \$35, with certain restaurants serving lunch or brunch for \$12. The week of promotion will last one week, until January 21.

“Downtown’s dining scene has never been more vibrant,” said Mary Miller, president and CEO of Downtown Norfolk Council. “We have something for everyone from fresh seafood to barbecue and international cuisine. For our Downtown workers, there’s an opportunity to enjoy Restaurant Week during lunch for a special two-course treat.”

This year will include several new restaurants, including Grain, Blue Moon Taphouse, Guy Fieri’s Smokehouse, Stripers Waterside and Varia.
