

Downtown Norfolk co-working space expanding after success

Percolator, a co-working space developed, owned and operated by developer Bobby Wright at 259 Granby St. in downtown Norfolk, recently reached its capacity and so is opening another location a block away at 253 Monticello Ave. near MacArthur Center.

Percolator opened quietly in late 2017 but has added clients over the past six months ranging from filmmakers to architects to cloud-based service providers, according to a news release.

The 10,000-square-foot space with amenities like ping pong and foosball tables was originally designed for game manufacturer Decipher, Wright said. The open design includes collaboration and audio/visual rooms in addition to flex and dedicated desks and office spaces.

Percolator members also get membership to the adjacent Gym Downtown, according to a news release.

The second campus includes 20,000 square feet of office space office space on the second floor and third floors of a 70,000-square-foot building that has space for special events and training on the first floor, according to a news release.
