Here's how it works: visit the downtown council's [website](#) to find out what restaurants are participating. More than two dozen restaurants are listed, along with the special pricing for the week. Lunches are \$12 and dinners are \$25 to \$35. Click on the meal you prefer and you will see the restaurant's menu.

So click away. Then get out your little black book, most likely a cell phone these days, and make some plans to sample your way around our tasty city. Remember, monthly parking pass hours are good until 9 p.m. and on-street parking is free after 6 p.m.
